MAP/NCLB Communication Arts Proficiency

1. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Communication Arts test will increase by an average of 6.3% each year.
2. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Grades 3-5 Communication Arts test will increase by an average of 6.9% each year.
3. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Grades 6-8 Communication Arts test will increase by an average of 6.1 % each year.
4. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Grades 9-11 Communication Arts test will increase by an average of 6.7 % each year.

MAP/NCLB Mathematics Proficiency

5. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Mathematics test will increase by an average of 6.9% each year.
6. Over the next five years, the percent of all students scoring proficient or above on the MAP Grades 3-5 Mathematics test will increase by an average of 7.8% each year.
7. Over the next five years, the percent of all student scoring proficient or above on the MAP 6-8 will increase by an average of 6.5 % each year.
8. Over the next five years, the percent of all student scoring proficient or above on the MAP 9-11 Mathematics test will increase by an average of 6.3% each year.

Reading Proficiency

9. Over the next five years, the percent of all students reading at or above grade level will increase by an average of 3.7% each year.
10. Over the next five years, the percent of all students reading at or above grade level in Grades 2-5 will increase by an average of 3.8% each year.
11. Over the next five year, the percent of all students reading at or above grade level in Grades 6-8 will increase by an average of 3.0% each year.
12. Over the next five years, the percent of all students reading at or above grade level in Grades 9-10 will increase by an average of 4.4% each year.

MSIP APR Indicators

13. Over the next five years, the percent of all graduates scoring above the national average on the ACT will increase by 1.9% each year.
14. Over the next five years, the average percentage of 11th and 12th grade credit earned in Advanced Courses will increase each year.

15. Over the next five years, the percent of all 11th and 12th graders enrolled in Career Education courses will increase by 1.8% each year.
16. Over the next five years, the percentage of graduates entering college will increase by 2.0% each year.
17. Over the next five years, the percentage of identified students entering appropriate post-secondary placements will increase by 2.1% each year.
18. Over the next five years, the percentage of entering freshmen who graduate from high school will increase by 1.3% each year.
19. Over the next five years, the average attendance rate will increase by 0.2% each year.
