Classroom Behavior Plan & Consequences

Students are given a total of 6 sticks each day. A stick is taken for behavior that distracts the child or other children from learning. Sticks are also taken for behavior that distracts the teacher from teaching.

- 2. Verbal warning**
- 3. 5 minutes off recess**
- 4. 10 minutes off recess**

*Immediate office referral for fighting, offensive language, and/or extreme disrespect
